



ATR environmental targets and objectives 2008 – 2011



In continuation of ATR's environmental commitment and in accordance with the implementation of its corresponding Management System, activities affecting the environment are those pertaining to the following categories:

- ✓ Tertiary sector (white-collars)
- ✓ Personnel and site services
- ✓ Aircraft product life cycle
- ✓ Customer Training.

With regards to ATR's managerial dedication to the continuous improvement of its programme on the environment, our Blagnac and St Martin sites are committed to achieving the following targets:

1 –Waste sorting and waste management:

- 1-A. 80% of non-dangerous waste sorted
- 1-B. 70% of non-dangerous waste recovered for raw materials or energy
- 1-C. 100% of dangerous waste processed by approved organisations

2 –Consumption of raw materials:

- 2-A. 5% reduction in paper consumption on identical levels of production and payroll.
- 2-B. 5% reduction on the electricity consumption of the Blagnac site
- 2-C. 100% house-management of all chemical products, in compliance with regulations (Management of stock and consumption, labeling of containers, Safety data sheets ...)

3 –Pollution Control:

- 3-A. Definition and application of an appropriate Company Travel Plan
- 3-B. Application of ground and water pollution prevention measures
- 3-C. Application of Air pollution prevention measures

4 –Regulatory compliance

- ✓ Validation for both our Blagnac and St Martin sites.

Two organisations (Environment and REACH) have been set up to achieve:

- ✓ our objectives and targets
- ✓ renewal and extension of our ISO 14001 certification perimeter.

It is reminded that the commitment of each and every one of us in ATR, including sub-contractors and partners, is necessary for the above programme to be successful.
